THE DIOCESE has learned of a Caller ID Spoofing scam in at least one of our parishes. People have reported that they received a call that shows on their Caller ID as being from the parish. The caller claims to be selling something on behalf of the parish. If you suspect you are the recipient of a "spoofing" call, inform the parish then contact your telephone service provider for information on how to prevent the scam. Most important, never give personal information over the phone to someone you don't know—especially your Social Security number, bank account, or credit card number. "Spoofing" is one method used to get that personal information for fraudulent use.
