- * Volunteers are needed to take down the tables following the event.

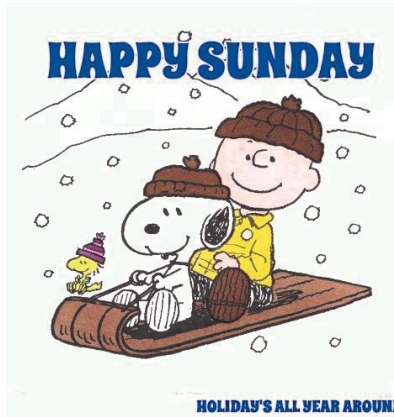
